



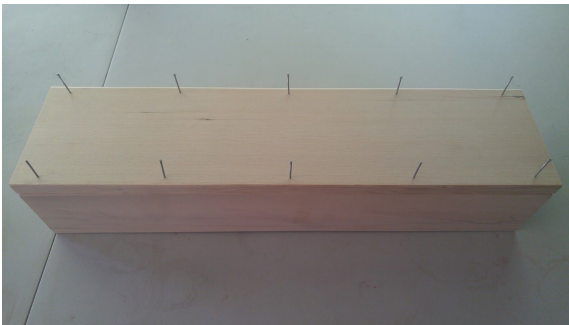

# DIY Art Caddy

## Materials List

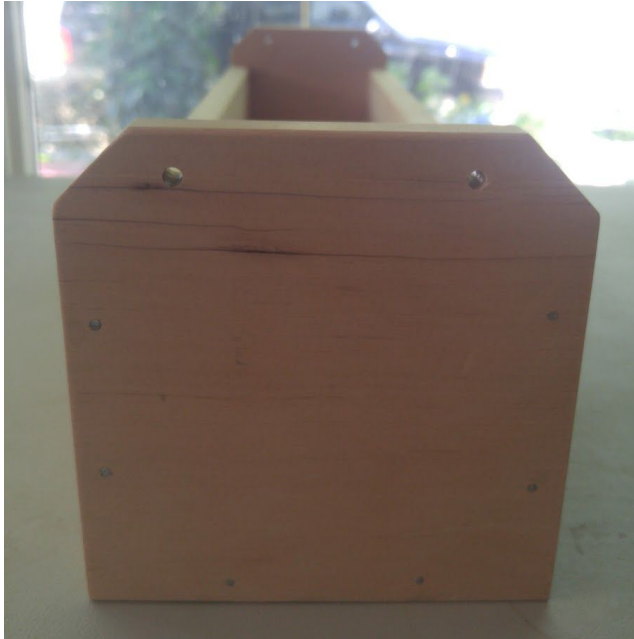
- (1) 1x6x22" Pine or Hemlock
- (2) 1x6x5.5" Pine or Hemlock with 45 degree miters on the top corners
- (2) 1x4x22" Pine or Hemlock
- (22) 1 ½" Finish Nails
- (1) Quart Water Based Stain
- (2) 3" Pulls



- 1. Start ten 1 ½" nails in the 1x6 bottom piece**
  
- 2. Set the bottom piece on top of the two 1x4 side pieces, lining them up so the edges are flush.**
  
- 3. Drive all of the nails in with a hammer.**



4. **Predrill holes for the pulls near the top of the end pieces and start 6 nails in each.**



5. **Line up the end pieces with the sides and bottom and drive all of the nails.**



6. **Your unfinished art caddy will look like this.**



**7. Stain or paint your art caddy to any color of your liking. We chose a purple water based stain for ours.**



**8. Install the pulls on each end and your caddy is ready to fill with art supplies!**
