
ADDRESS PLANTER BOX



MATERIALS

- 1x4 18" cedar (3) (back)
- 1x412" cedar (1) (front)
- 1x410½" cedar (1) (bottom)
- 1x4 3½" cedar (2) (sides)
- 1¼" stainless pocket screws (6) \
- 1¼" stainless nails (12)
- Picture hanging D-ring hooks (2) ♣
- ½" screws (2) \
- 21/2" house numbers **123**
- Stain

ASSEMBLY TOOLS

- Hammer
- Tape measure
- Pencil \
- Drill 🤼
- Kreg jigs dreg
- 12" clamps 🔨
- Nail gun
- Foam brush















STEP ONE

Build the back panel by attaching the three 1x4 18" pieces with six 1¼" stainless pocket screws using a Kreg jig and the drill.



STEP TWO . 8

Add the two D-ring hooks to the upper part of the back panel using the two ½" screws.



STEP THREE

Make the box by attaching the 1x4 12" front piece to the two 1x4 3½" side pieces and the 10½" bottom with six 1¼" stainless nails.




STEP FOUR \(\bigcirc \bigcirc

Use tape measure to mark the nail locations on the lower right back side; attach the box to the back panel with six 1¼" stainless nails.

Stain the Address
Planter Box the color
of your choice using the
foam brush and wood
stain, or leave the wood
bare if desired.



STEP SIX \ 123 \

Install the house numbers using the screws included with the number kit and the drill



STEP SEVEN

Add potting soil & plants to box; hang in desired location and enjoy!
